

Regular Meeting

August 13, 1990

7:00 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Commissioners of Bridgeville was brought to order by President Gilefski at 7:00 pm. Present were Commissioners Tull, Willey, Slater and Evans. Guest present were John Loscomb, Doug Jones, Dianne Willey, Jerry Mars of the Leader, Mr. Stephen Cina, Chief Orr, Patty & James Rodan, Mr. Charles Royal.

A motion was then made by Commissioner Willey, second by Commissioner Tull. So approved. Minutes are available for public view at any time.

Bills were presented for payment . After review by all commissioners, a motion was made to pay all bills. So approved.

Commissioner Gilefski then read a letter from Mr. Rick Hyde, chairman of the Bridgeville board of adjustments who has resigned and moved out of town. Commissioner Gilefski then announced that he has appointed a replacement for Mr. Hyde. Rob Perciful is now chairman of the Board of Adjustments for the Town of Bridgeville.

The oil recycling tank that the Commissioners put in the town parking lot has been on a trial bases has been checked weekly by Griecgo. It is monitored every week and they have already picked up three hundred gallons of oil. Everyone in town is encouraged to use this facility for recycling of oil.

Commissioner Gilefski then made everyone aware of the industrial pretreatment monitoring report by CABA Assoc. There were numerous violations by Shore Best Poultry, Inc. They have been sent the second letter giving them ninety day for corrective action. The Commissioners will be doing everything that they can to make sure that they are within their permit limits.

The Commissioners then had a discussion as to weather or not Perdue, Inc. located on the outside of town could be tied into the town sewer system. They have given the Town of Bridgeville a deposit for the purpose of the Commissioners engaging a engineering firm to evaluate the options. The engineering firm will be George, Miles and Buhr. Motion by Commissioner Tull, second by Commissioner Evans to approve the contract.

A motion was made by Commissioner Slater and second by Commissioner Willey for replacement of twenty two windows in the Town of Bridgeville hall. This should be completed

before winter.

Commissioner's Reports:

Alderman's Court- Alderman's report was excepted as presented.

Police Department- Police report was excepted as presented.

Water Department- Water report was excepted as presented.

Street Department- Commisssioner Slater reported that the new signs may be installed at any time.

Citizen's Privilege- Commissioner Gilefski read a letter concerning Jerry Jones and Laverty Lanes on what the Commissioners wanted. There will be a stockade fence and lighting installed. Mr. Cina made it aware to the Board of Commissioners a problem with Miller's Fabricated Metals blocking the sidewalk with vehicles and equipment. Also that there are sidewalks that need to have weeds trimmed. James Rodan spoke to the Commissioners concerning his mother in laws property being restored. Mr. Royal commended the Police Dept. He said that everything is looking great.


A motion was made by Commissioner Slater and second by Commissioner Tull to go into executive session at 7:55 P.M. So moved.
