

Regular Meeting
December 11, 1989

Commissioners of Bridgeville
8:00 pm

The regular meeting of the Commissioners of Bridgeville was brought to order by President Gilefski at 8:00 pm. In attendance were Commissioners Willey, Crockett, Evans and Tull. (Guest list attached to minutes). The pledge of allegiance was held. Commissioner Willey made a motion to dispose with the reading of the minutes from the last regular meeting and the special meeting on November 30th, 1989. Motion seconded by Commissioner Tull. So carried. After examination of bills presented to each commissioner, a motion was made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Willey to pay all bills. So moved.

For Information:

President Gilefski reported that there will be a Commissioners Election, on Tuesday, January 2, 1990 in the Town Hall from 12 to 7 pm. One candidate has filed at this time, that being Mr. Robert Slater for a two year post.

Alderman's Report-attached to minutes.

Commissioner's Reports:

Streets-Commissioner Tull reported that the paving that had been planned for this year has been completed. He also reported that we will try to catch a few spots more when the funds become available. Snow removal has been going well.

Sewer-Commissioner Evans reported that the storage building has been completed. Also, a new roof has been put on the digester building. The plant has been operating very well.

Water-Commissioner Willey had no report.

Police-Commissioner Crockett reported the total arrest for the month. No other report.

Citizen's Privilege-Michael Collison stated that when he resigned in September, 1989, he was working on several projects and would like to have a follow-up on those projects: first, the delinquent taxes. President Gilefski reported that the town lawyer had notified those people that January 1, 1990 would be the deadline for paying their property taxes. The next question was the resume from Mr. Mars for the position of assistant town manager and grantsman. Commissioner Tull added that he had been informed of the resume, but that no decision was definite.

Mr. Collison addressed the idea of hiring a grantsman. He then asked each commissioner their personal view. Commissioner Willey then made a motion to discuss further the possibility of hiring a grantsman/or town manager, if need be, seconded by Commissioner Crockett. Mr. Collison then added that he had been contact with Donna Buckle from the Housing Rehabilitation Program. He asked if the commissioners have done anything since then. President Gilefski stated that he has as his priority the debt from the waste treatment plant that has not been paid off.

Erica Smith from the Woodbridge Key Club announced that there will be a Meet the Candidates Night on December 14, 1989 at the high school.

Mr. Hunsberger asked that a date be set for meeting together as soon as possible concerning the water line to his property.

A motion was made by Commissioner Crockett to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Tull. So moved.

Mr. Charles Royal asked that the problem of people parking on streets where they should not be. Commissioner Crockett will be in contact with Mr. Royal in the next two weeks. Mr. Johnny Banks also expressed his concerns about the same individual and also stated his concern that the same person has a pit bull that runs loose.

The meeting was then adjourned.
