

Commissioners of Bridgeville
February 12, 1990

8:00 PM

The regular meeting of the Town of Bridgeville was brought to order at 8:00 pm by President Gilefski. Commissioners present were Lance Willey, Bob Slater, James Evans and Daryl Tull. Following the flag salute, a motion was made by Daryl Tull, seconded by Commissioner Willey, to dispense with the reading of the regular minutes from the last regular meeting and the two special meetings on February 1st and 5th, but to approve them as presented. So approved.

Approval of Bills:

After review by each department commissioner, a motion was made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Tull to pay all bills as presented. So carried.

For Information:

President Gilefski announced that there will be a budget workshop on Thursday, February 15, starting at 7:00 pm. Each commissioner was asked to have a rough draft for that night.

Update on Hunsberger 10" water line- President Gilefski informed the commissioners that the line is now complete. Commissioner Willey will contact Mr. Hunsberger and have him present copies of work invoices and a bottom line figure so that the town may pay their share. Also, Commissioner Willey talk with Mr. Hunsberger concerning an easement agreement so that there are no problems in the future when maintenance needs to be done on the water line. Doug Jones, town employee added that the town will be putting in a 6" line in place of the 4" line which will feed back to our property.

Update on FmHA loan and grant- President Gilefski informed the commissioners that a closing date is being set up at this time with our town solicitor and FmHA.

Commissioners' Reports-

Police Department:

Commissioner Tull gave each commissioner a written report.

Sewer Department:

Commissioner Evans reported a few minor repairs at the treatment plant.

Water Department:

Commissioner Willey reported that the Hunsberger project is almost completed. The town will be tearing out an old 4" line and lay a new 6" line on the west side, doing the work at the same time that Mr. Hunsberger will be laying his line

to his property. The project cost will be minimal to the town.

Street Department:

Commissioner Slater had nothing to report on streets. He did, however, report on the Election Committee findings. A copy of the findings and recommendations is attached. After discussion by the commissioners on the suggested recommendations, President added that he will contact Mr. Schrader concerning the change of charter needed to accommodate new cutoff dates for filing and registration.


