Richard Thomas, of Bicentennial Committee, presented Bicentennial Plate #1 to Town Commissioners to be kept permanently in Town Office.


Raymond Montsch from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Delaware discussed rates and benefits compared with independent Insurance Companies.
