

REGULAR MEETING  
JANUARY 14, 1991

PRESIDENT SLATER CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT APPROX. 7:10 P.M. WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. THE NEW COMMISSIONERS WERE WELCOMED TO THE COMMISSION BY PRESIDENT SLATER.

ALDERMAN REPORT-(SEE COPY ATTACHED) WAS PRESENTED. MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER EVANS AND SECOND BY COMMISSIONER COLLISON TO APPROVE THE REPORT AS PRESENTED. APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

PRESIDENT SLATER CALLED FOR CITIZEN'S PRIVILEGE- MR. WALTER MARS ASKED ABOUT THE TWO ADDITIONAL "IF YOU LIVED HERE YOU WOULD BE HOME NOW." SIGNS. PRESIDENT SLATER SAID THEY WERE STILL PREPARED AS WE HAD TOLD THE SIGN COMPANY THAT WE WERE NOT IN A HURRY FOR THEM. PHILLIP DAVIS ASKED IF ANY DECISION HAD BEEN MADE ON MAKING COOPER ALLEY A ONE WAY STREET. PRESIDENT SLATER SAID IT HAD BEEN LOOKED AT , BUT IT WILL BE BROUGHT UP AT THE NEXT COMMISSIONERS MEETING.
