

COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE
REGULAR MEETING
JANUARY 8, 1979

Meeting was called to order by President Robert L. Mulvaney.

Mr. Mulvaney read some of the bills listed for payment. Motion was made by Mr. Earl Willey and seconded by Mr. William Hartzell to pay all bills here attached.

A letter of thanks for money given to the Bridgeville Volunteer Fire Co. was read by Mr. Mulvaney. They also requested funds for electric bills for the year of 1979. This request was moved by Mr. Willey and seconded by Mr. Harry Short to be tabled at this time.

A letter will be sent to Rev. Charles Sorrells denying his request to purchase the old landfill area owned by the Town.

Mr. Norman Powell Advisor of HUD stated that the present project is to clean up homes (dwellings) not fit for living conditions.

The time is too late to get funds for repairs (fixing) of dwellings, (reason being lack of existing staff people).

There will be a call meeting of the Board January 17, 1979 at 7 P. M. with Mr. Clark Carbaugh to go over all matters of the Waste Treatment Plant. Mr. Carbaugh is to meet with Mr. Short to discuss weigh scale agreement cost dated January 11, 1979.


President Mulvaney asked that Mr. Coverdale of G. E. Jones & Co. who does the town's plumbing to leave a call number so that the town may contact him in case of emergency.

Mr. Charles Sampson of CATV was here to talk about cable T. V. in the Town of Bridgeville. The cost would be \$6.95 a month plus \$1.50 per additional set. They asked for an allowed 5% yearly cost increase if inflation calls for it. Mr. Sampson is to send a contract to be reviewed by the Board.

Motion was made by Mr. Earl Willey and seconded by Mr. Hartzell to buy an Electrolux Cleaner for the Town Hall for the price of \$379.50.
