

Commissioners of Bridgeville
Regular Meeting
June 11, 1990
7:00 pm

The regular meeting of the Commissioners of Bridgeville was brought to order by President Gilefski at 7:00 pm, followed by the flag salute. A motion was made by Commissioner Tull, seconded by Commissioner Willey to dispense with the reading of the minutes from the last regular meeting on May 14th. All approved.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

After review by each commissioner and questions concerning a belt for the greenhouse, a motion was made by Commissioner Slater, seconded by Commissioner Evans to pay bills, except for the bill for Sayre Thompson. (Belt for waste treatment plant) So carried.

FOR INFORMATION:

President Gilefski then introduced the new police chief, Mr. Handley J. Orr and welcomed him on board.

1st reading of the Flood Insurance Ordinance was then held. The second reading will be held in July.

DSHA representative Mr. Jerry Jones was then introduced. Jerry showed the commissioners a plot of the project and they would like to go with a five foot chain link vinyl coated fence around the area discussed. Commissioner Tull had reservations on that kind of fence due to trash, car lights and privacy for the residents involved. The commissioners are in favor of the stockade fence similar to the one around the project south of Dover. After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Slater, seconded by Commissioner Evans that the DSHA be directed by the Town to erect a stockade fence around the project. So moved. Input from the neighbors will be considered and a letter will then be sent to the Housing Authority. Jerry also reiterated that people with a Bridgeville address are first on the waiting list as tenants, contrary to rumors that now exist. Hopefully, the punch list will be carried out in August, with people moving in in September. Doug mentioned that before paving is done on the street leading into the project, the existing sewer line from the house that has been moved must be capped. Jerry also added the authority has asked their engineer to design a swail to be cut behind the Willins and Hammonds to alleviate the problem with stormwater runoff. Commissioner Slater made a motion that the commissioners insist on a stockade fence, seconded by Commissioner Evans. So moved.

Mr. Del Sordo from the Bureau of Archaeology and Historical Preservation was next on the agenda. He made a presentation concerning a possible historic district within the town. A survey has been conducted and Bridgeville has a nice collection of 19th and 20th century buildings, involving the core of the town. He asked for a letter of intent by August 1990 if they are interested. Mr. Del Sordo added that they would help do the paperwork, if needed.

Howard Hardesty presented his information on the new signs for the entrances to Bridgeville. After discussion and figures presented, a motion was made by Commissioner Slater, seconded by Commissioner Willey that the town give \$900 per sign (for a total of 4 signs-\$3600) All commissioners voting yes except Commissioner Tull. The Community Committee is to provide manpower for installation.

COMMISSIONERS REPORTS

Police Department-Commissioner Tull presented his written report and added that he had two items for executive session.

Sewer Department-Commissioner Evans had nothing to report.

Water Department-Commissioner Willey asked about the waste oil container out back. He added that it is the first one in the area. Mr. Evans stated that he has a security concern with the oil tank being located inside our fence. Mr. Willey has contacted Mrs. Bayliss and Mrs. Macleod. They are going to make an effort. Doug will move the tank to the outside of the fence adjacent to the igloos.

Street Department-Commissioner Slater stated that we have a contract on two streets that will be tar and chipped. Mr. Slater then talked about out of town property owners being allowed to vote. He then made a motion to change the charter to allow one vote per property to out of town owners. Dennis would have to work it such. The motion then died for lack of second. Lance added that he would like to get a more in-depth discussion before making a decision. Commissioners will hold a later discussion.

Commissioner Slater reported also, when questioned by Mike Collison, that the street sweeper for our district is broken down. Mr. John Nichols asked that possibly the SCI inmates could pick up the trash and sand from the streets. Lance will call SCI and find out if something can be worked up.

A motion was made by Commissioner Tull, seconded by Commissioner Evans to go into executive session. So moved at 8:20 pm.

At 9:30 pm, the commissioners came out of executive session. A motion was made by Commissioner Tull, seconded by Commissioner Willey, to hire Kevin Smith as a part-time police officer, begin immediately. Training will begin as soon as possible.

The meeting was then adjourned.
