

COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 8, 1972

Meeting called to order by President, Paul A. Lynch at 8 P.M.

Members present were Allen Jones, Earl Willey, T. J. Gray, Jr. and Norman Powell.

Robert Rider and W. C. Newton were also present from Newton Investment Company. Mr. Newton stated that the Company had purchased lots from Edwin James located on North Cannon St. and after land was surveyed they find that the town had black topped a road on their land of 4 1/2 ft. between North Cannon and First Street. The Newton Investment Company wanted to trade this land for a fifty foot easement at the West end of town land, formerly the Town Dump in order that they have an in and out entry to land owned by their Company. An entrance from existing road is all that was planned. Entry would meet State specifications. Mr. Rider and Mr. Newton then departed.

There were discussions on their request and a motion was made by Norman G. Powell and seconded by T. J. Gray, Jr. that right of egress and regress to a fifty foot strip on West end of former Town Dump land from route 584 to ditch be granted to Newton Investment Company for a consideration of \$500.00 and any and all legal cost of surveys will be the expense of Newton Investment Company. Motion passed.

Mr. Lynch reported that Leroy Truitt, Town Zoning Chairman and the Fire Marshall had discussed the Columbia Hotel property and that the Fire Marshall will be working on this project.

Motion made by Earl Willey and seconded by Allen Jones that following bills be paid.
