

COMMISSIONERS OF BRIDGEVILLE
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 8, 1978

Meeting was called to order by President Simons at 8 P. M.

Commissioners present were Mr. William Hartzell, Mr. Jack Simons, Mr. Earl C. Willey and Mr. James Evans.

R. Francis Adams was present to present his concern about deed to alley adjacent to his store. (Rear to store).

Visitors to meeting were: Connie Hicks and Cindy Hartzell, Del Tech students; also Linda Hammond, Seaford Leader and Virgil Kinder, Alderman.

Previous minutes approved as read.

Bills attached in the amount of \$5,518.53 were approved for payment.

Mr. Adams questioned why funds (Federal) could not be used to improve Cannon Street as well as Church Street and other part of Cannon Street. He stated that he would like to see this area of Cannon Street improved.

Bill from Sam Shannahan for \$4,693.00 for replacement of #1 well was approved to be paid from the Sinking Fund.

President Simons read a letter from Woodbridge School stating appreciation for Police effort in controlling traffic around the school.

President Simons read letter from Betts & Schrader concerning a building code for the Town of Bridgeville. Item tabled until later date.

Motion made, seconded and passed to have CABA Associates to prepare a comprehensive plan of public improvements for the town.

Motion made, seconded and passed to purchase 25 water meters during the remainder of this fiscal year.

Motion made, seconded and passed to authorize Norman G. Powell to provide CABA Associates with listing of properties to be considered under the current HUD Project and authorize CABA Associates to proceed with the project as required by HUD.

President Simons appointed Commissioner James Evans as Waste Treatment Commissioner.

President Simons has requested Sam Shannahan Well Co. to develop a maintenance program for town wells and pump equipment. Results to be considered by the Commission at a later date.

Police report was presented by Commissioner Hartzell.

Commissioner Willey presented the latest information on the Railroad Avenue situation - 3 possibilities - all acceptable to the state.

Motion made, seconded and approved to accept price of \$1,125.00 to install sewer line and catch basin on Maple Alley.

Commissioner Willey reported that pot holes have been repaired on town streets.

Motion made, seconded and passed to purchase a chair for the Alderman's Court - price not to exceed \$150.00 plus freight.

Motion made, seconded and passed to purchase a calculator for a price of \$179.95.

Motion made, seconded and passed to grant policemen as paid by the Town of Bridgeville a 5% pay increase effective May 15th, 1978.
