Thurman W. Adams and Howard Hardesty presented a letter purporting to authenticate the date of the founding of Bridgeville.


Motion made, seconded and approved that the Bridgeville Town Board on this date of November 8, 1976, do hereby accept and recognize the founding date of 1684 as the official founding date of the Town of Bridgeville as evidenced by documents (MD-SD #A,FF, 330-331) put forth by the Bridgeville Historical Society and accepted by the "Division of Historical & Cultural Affairs" of the State of Delaware.

Motion made, seconded and approved that the Bridgeville Historical Society is the agent authorized to compile all historical information and pertinent data pertaining to the Town of Bridgeville until an authorized tercentenary committee be appointed on January 1, 1981, or at least three years before a celebration is to take place.

Motion made and approved that CABB Associates be approved as Engineers on the proposed Public Works Project and EDA Program. The pre-application Engineering cost will not exceed \$4,000.00 per CABB Associate's letter of November 3, 1976.
