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INITIAL RESPONSE BY PATROL OFFICERS

- INITIAL CALL FOR SERVICE
- PATROL OFFICER RESPONSE
- SECURE THE SCENE
- SEPARATE ALL PARTIES (VICTIMS / SUSPECTS / WITNESSES)
- ASCERTAIN THE CRIME
- CALL DETECTIVES AND CRIME SCENE UNIT

- INITIAL OBSERVATIONS / WALKTHROUGH
- PHOTOGRAPH / VIDEO DOCUMENTATION
- SKETCH (MEASUREMENTS)
- EVIDENCE SEARCH, DOCUMENTATION, & COLLECTION
- BLOOD PATTERN DOCUMENTATION & ANALYSIS
- SHOOTING & FLIGHT PATH DOCUMENTATION AND ANALYSIS
- DETAILED REPORTS OF FINDINGS
- FORENSIC / SCIENTIFIC / MEDICAL EXAMINER ANALYSIS

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THINGS TO REMEMBER!!!

- CRIMES ARE NOT SOLVED IN 43 MINUTES.



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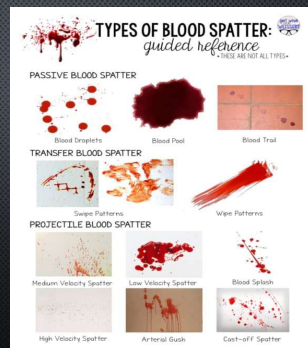
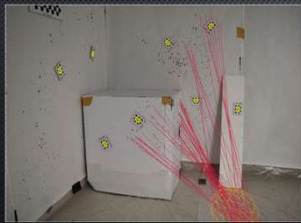

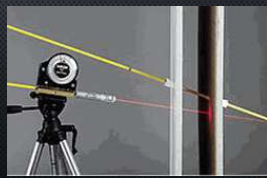
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BLOOD PATTERNS



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SHOOTING & FLIGHT PATH DOCUMENTATION AND ANALYSIS



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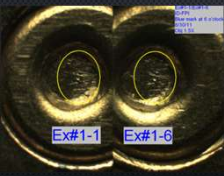

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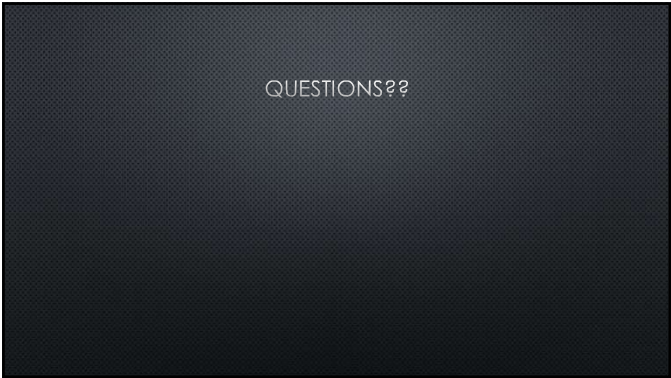
