

RESOLUTION 2026-02

AFFIRMATIVELY FURTHERING FAIR HOUSING

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Bridgeville recognize the importance of fair housing for the citizens of Bridgeville; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Bridgeville support the goals of the Federal Fair Housing Law,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of Bridgeville heartily encourage all parties involved in the renting, selling or financing of housing in the Commission of Bridgeville to ensure that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, religion, creed, sex, marital status, familial status, age, sexual orientation or disability be discriminated against or denied a fair and equal opportunity to housing.

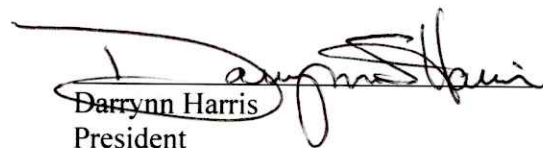
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of Bridgeville take meaningful actions that, taken together, address significant disparities in housing needs and in access to opportunity, replacing segregated living patterns with truly integrated and balanced living patterns, transforming racially or ethnically concentrated areas of poverty into areas of opportunity, and fostering and maintaining compliance with civil rights and fair housing laws.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of Bridgeville, when acting as administrator of a Community Block Grant, are hereby authorized to take such actions as deemed necessary to affirmatively further fair housing in connection with the said Community Development Block Grant.

The Resolution was passed by a vote of the Commissioners of Bridgeville on June 8, 2026.
